“Ti nako . . . kimwareirei, n anenei anene n taromauri, ao ni karabwa te Atua.”

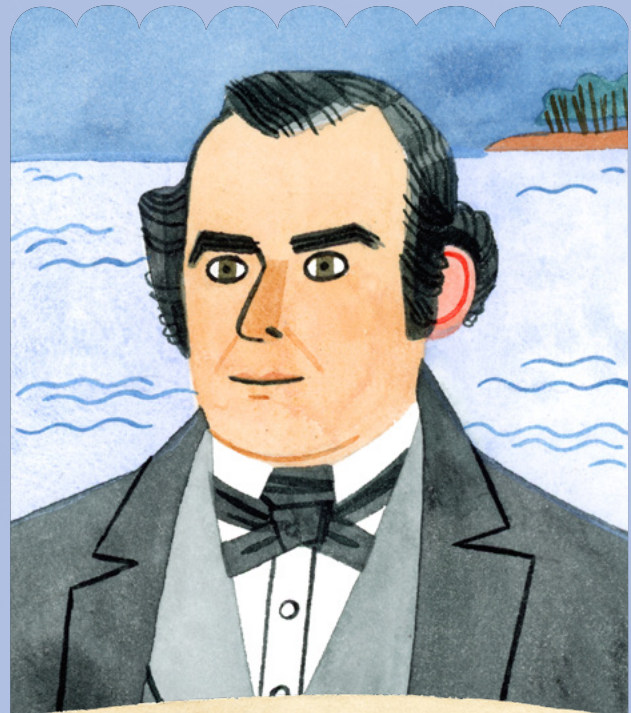
- E kaaina te Ekaretia i Connecticut, USA.
