## **Temple Square Performances for April 2019**

A variety of concerts and performances on Temple Square will take place during the month of April. These concerts are free unless otherwise noted. All are open to the public.

### **Friday, April 12 – Choral Arts Society of Utah Spring Concert – Featuring “Requiem” by Gabriel Faure**

This choir of over 100 singers come together under the direction of Sterling Poulson. Just returning from a performance in Carnegie Hall performing the Faure Requiem, and dedicating the performance to Sterling’s late wife, Danette Poulson, this concert is a continuation of that memorial. The Choral Arts Society will be joined by members of the Morgan Community Choir conducted by Lois Manning. This event will be held at 7:30 p.m. in the Assembly Hall.

### **Saturday, April 13 – NATS Winners Concert**

The NATS (National Association of Teachers of Singing) competition will be held at the University of Utah on March 23, 2019. The category winners of that competition will be showcased during this Temple Square concert which takes place at 7:30 p.m. in the Assembly Hall.

### **Wednesday, April 17 – UPMC Salt Lake Area Piano Honors Recital**

The Utah Federation of Music Clubs (UFMC) is a group of over 60 piano teachers with 1000 students. Together they bring their best students to perform in this honors recital. The event will be held at 7:30 p.m. in the Assembly Hall.

### **Friday and Saturday, April 19 and 20 – The Tabernacle Choir at Temple Square Easter Concert**

“He Is Risen: A Sacred Easter Presentation” is the Tabernacle Choir and Orchestra at Temple Square’s annual Easter concert at 7:30 p.m. both nights.
